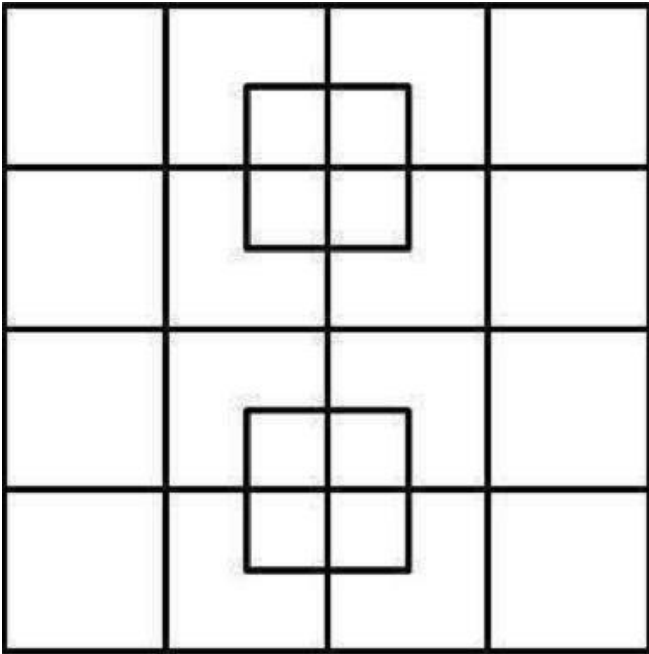

4. Famous at a Funeral- Widow of Nain whose son Jesus raised- Luke 7:11-15
5. Famous for Persistence- Widow who nagged Judge until he granted her her request- Luke 18:1-5
6. Famous for establishing a Church Office- Greek Widows who were neglected in daily feeding and from which the office of Deacon was begun- Acts 6:1-6

What is **attributed** to those who visit the Fatherless and Widows in their affliction- Pure Religion. James 1:27

I. The **Protection** offered a Widow- Ex 22:22-24 *Ye shall not afflict any widow, or fatherless child. If thou afflict them in any wise, and they cry at all unto me, I will surely hear their cry; And my wrath shall wax hot, and I will kill you with the sword; and your wives shall be widows, and your children fatherless.* Ps 68:5 *A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in his holy habitation.* Ps 146:9 *The Lord preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down.*

II. The **Responsibility** Widows incur- Numbers 30:9 *But every vow of a widow, and of her that is divorced, wherewith they have bound their souls, shall stand against her.* (In contrast to a wife who must have the approval of her husband to enter a contract).

III. The **Provision** for Widows- DEU 14:28-29 *At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates: And the Levite, (because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee,) and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which are within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.*

DEU 24:19 *When thou cuttest down thine harvest in thy field, and hast forgot a sheaf in the field, thou shalt not go again to fetch it: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hands.*

1TIM 5:3-6 *Honour widows that are widows indeed. But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God. Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day. But she that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth.*

Final Admonition- Jer 49:11 *Leave thy fatherless Children, I will preserve them alive; and let thy widows trust in me.*
